- Michelle advised that we should be preparing stakeholders for the changes that we are thinking of making imminently
- The WHO have lots of training materials that we can tap into to support us in preparing our stakeholders for these changes

## **5. Note on Data from the Compulsion Group**

- It has been noted that the issues raised as a result of this data span across the work of the review and therefore it would be beneficial for all advisory groups to look at this data in the context of their own area.
